HOW DO I SET UP & PLAY?

Curiosity Spark - How far can you throw a light and a heavy object?

- Draw a line on carpet or cement with chalk or masking tape
- Place the balls, beanbags and cotton balls in easy reach of the children.
- Encourage them to choose objects and begin throwing toward the line and see if they notice any differences.
- What objects go further? Are they light or heavy? Why do the cotton balls not go far when thrown?

EXTENDING LEARNING SPARKS

- Go on a scavenger hunt around the room or yard to find more objects then sort into heavy or light piles.
- Set up a weighing provocation with scales.
- Compare the scavenger hunt items collected and identify the objects that are short or long.

WHAT MATERIALS DO I NEED?

- 1 packet cotton balls
- Collection of small balls, beanbags or similar.
- Masking tape or chalk
